Decree of the Rector No. 1/2018,

which regulates the fees connected with studies for the 2018/2019 academic year

With validity from 1 October 2018, I issue this decree on fees connected with studies:

Article 1

Setting the base for calculating fees connected with studies

1. Under Section 58 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments to Other Acts (hereinafter the "Act"), as amended, and under Articles 20 and 21 of the Statutes (hereinafter the "Statutes") of the Academy of Performing Arts in Prague (hereinafter "AMU"), fees connected with studies are derived from a so-called "base". The base is announced by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports (hereinafter "MŠMT"). The base is valid for the academic year beginning in this calendar year.

2. The **base** for setting the fees connected with studies has been set by MŠMT for the academic year starting in 2018 in the letter File No. MSMT-2002/2017-1 from 25 January 2018 in the amount of CZK 3,498 (to wit: three thousand four hundred ninety-eight Czech crowns).

3. This decree is specified by Methodological Directive of the Vice-Rector No. 2/2017, on fees connected with studies.

Article 2

Amount of fees connected with studies

1. **Fees for actions connected with the admissions process** are income of the main activity and amount to:

The fee for submitting an application for admission to studies amounts to CZK 699 (six hundred ninety-nine Czech crowns).

2. **Fees connected with studies** for individual Bachelor's and Master's programmes are income of the scholarship fund and amount to:

The fee for longer studies, under Section 58(3) of the Act and Art. 18 of the AMU Statutes, is CZK 15,741 (fifteen thousand seven hundred forty-one Czech crowns) for each additional six months of studies or part thereof.

3. **Fees connected with studying in an academic programme realised in a foreign language** (under Section 58(4) of the Act) are income of the main activity and are stipulated in the AMU Statutes, Article 20(5).

Article 3

Form of payment and due date of fees

1. Fees per Art. 2 of this decree are to be paid by means of a cashless transfer to AMU's bank account.
2. The due date for the fees specified in Art. 2(1) is a function of the deadline for submitting applications for admission to studies.
3. The fee specified in Art. 2(2) is due within 90 days following delivery of the decision on the assessment of the fee.
4. The fee specified in Art. 2(3) is due in two instalments no later than on the 15th day of the calendar month in which the semester in question began. Details are stipulated in the agreement on foreign student studies.
5. After paying the fees specified above, the student or participant is required to present the payment receipt to the Registrar's Office (Studijní oddělení) for inspection.

Article 4

Fee relief

The Rector may reduce, waive or postpone the due date of the fees specified in Art. 2(2-3), generally by recommendation of the Dean of the faculty in which the student is registered, in the event of:

- a) excellent academic results,
- b) a burdensome social situation or other serious reasons.

This decree shall take effect on the day of its announcement, and Decree of the Rector No. 2/2017 is cancelled as of 1 October 2018.
